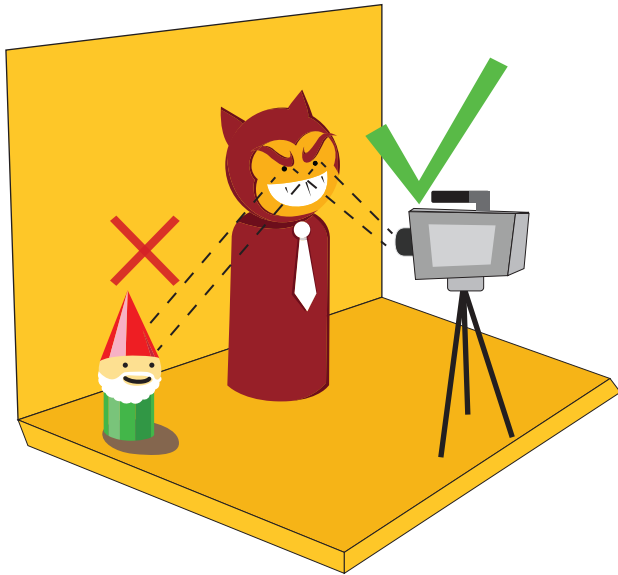




TIP #1

Look at the camera. The camera is your virtual audience and creates eye contact for viewers when they watch the video.



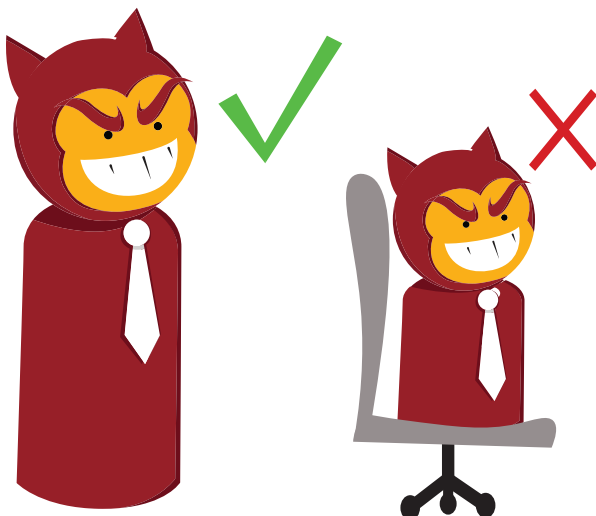
TIP #2

Speak in your “presenter voice”. Speak in a louder volume for best audio quality results.



TIP #3

Stand when you present. Standing gives good posture and allows for expressive body language.



RECAP

- Focus your view on the camera to promote eye contact with the “audience” for the video.
- Speak clearly and loud for the best audio quality.
- Stand up to present, it promotes hand gestures and is less restrictive for breathing.
